

**1** On the **Asset Details** screen, you can load assets onto the proposal.

To begin, select an **Asset Type**. This selection will define the form presented to you for completion.

Generally speaking, you will be asked for the **Asset Type**, **Asset Classification**, **Manufacturer** and **Model** (which are dropdown selections for car assets), **Quantity**, **Asset Cost**, **VAT Exemption**, **Asset Condition**, **Year of Manufacture** and **Serial No.**

**2** For *all wheeled assets*, there is also **Registration No.** and the Serial No. field becomes **VIN**.

For *Finance Lease* products, you are able to provide a **Residual Value**.

**3** The radio button selection near the foot of the page allows you to indicate if a supplier is known or not.

Indicating "**No**" allows you to continue on the proposal journey.

Indicating "**Yes**" requires you to first select who the supplier is. There are five options which appear – **Search for Supplier**, **Customer**, **Introducer**, **Novuna**, and **Franchised Dealer**.

**4** Searching for supplier prompts you to search for third parties in the system to use as the supplier. Those in **bold** have previously been used as a supplier and those which aren't in bold need to first be linked as suppliers.

The other options do not require a search and will mark the supplier as the chosen checkbox (either Customer, Introducer, Novuna or Franchised Dealer) within the **Asset List**.

**5** Setting the **Quantity** to anything greater than one will add a new asset line with duplicated information to the **Asset List** for that asset. Alternatively, clicking **New Asset** on the **Asset List** screen will allow you to add another unique asset to the proposal.

The vertical ellipsis on the **Asset List** shows the option to **Edit** or **Remove** when clicked, allowing for asset details to be amended or the asset removed entirely from the proposal.

**Note:** There is not an asset screen when selecting loan products.
